
The design aims to:

- -The site must reveal an interesting past which relates to a date between 1865-2015

- -Clustering of sites
- -Convenient start/finish point
- -Length of walk (time taken as well as distance walked)
- -Distance between sites

Having researched other cities as well as Wellington's City Walks the general themes were:

-History

- -Architecture -Adventure
 - ture –Nature
- -Arts/Culture -Local Interest
- -Food/Drink

At the moment my project seems to fall mainly into history with a hint of architecture, culture and local interest along with a discovery element.

Breakdown of sets

Some of the overriding similarities/themes when looking at the locations are:

- -Reclamation
- -Street names
- -Transport
- -Alleyways/tunnels/bridges/steps connector spaces
- -Derelict sites (abandoned buildings/ruins/empty spaces, where buildings have been removed but nothing has been put in their place)

Some themes such as

Hospitals WWs

Recreation

were researched and the discarded due to insufficient facts or not enough sites relating to the theme within the time period.

The in between sites vary tremendously in that although they are all in between spaces, their quirky or interesting history does not always relate to another site either in theme or time.

The site histories are so varied that they seemingly cannot be grouped in sets very readily.

This led me to explore the geographical and time line aspects rather than try to create groups that are simply not there.

When looking at the geographical positioning of the sites (see map of Wellington), it seemed logical to create routes and then further explore those routes/extend the routes to discover other sites along the journey. Which would then correspond to the 1865–2015 time period.

The jumping back and fourth over time is an important factor to consider when devising the routes. Can it work? Is the alternative/unseen/unwrapped Wellington theme enough to hold them together.






Scollon & Scollon consider any area of the cityscape to be a 'semiotic aggregate' formed of multiplicity of discourses. Signs make meaning in relation to where land when they are physically placed in the material world, (Scollon & Scollon, 2003). A primary focus in geosemiotics is indexically in which signs depend on their context for meaning.

The city presents itself to us full of messages. The efficacy of letter-forms goes beyond their verbal meaning. Following letter trails we find trajectories that lead us to culture and heritage.








Typographic remnants are indexical signs. It is their geosemiotic meaning [Scollon & Scollon, 2003] which has been shifted by the ad-vancement of their surroundings. In order to fully understand their semiotics, their historical context must be uncovered.


The data collected was collated and each remnant received an infocard.


Using the data acquired from the secondary research a timeline was produced for the Cuba Quarter. On a grid structure, the timeline goes from 1865 to 2011 horizontally.




